



## RED ROSE CHAPTER AWARD

**Why?** This program is designed to recognize well rounded chapters who contribute to the State Program of Work! They must take part in member development, community service, conferences, leadership activities, national programs, and competitive events.

**How?** In order to be recognized with this award, chapters must complete all of the required elements as well as 20 out of 100 possible points of the Additional Point Options. The point values are in red next to the description below. An official application form must be filled out to give proof of completion.

**When?** Applications are due on March 1st and chapters will be recognized at the SLC during the Recognition Dinner when their chapter presidents go on stage to receive the award.

### **Requirements:**



- \*Increase your chapter’s membership.
- \*Chapter participation at the Fall Leadership Connection (8 members)
- \*Participated in 4 Fall Competitive Events
- \*Chapter attendance at Leadership Bootcamp (at least 6 members and 1 adviser)
- \*Participate in the State Leadership Conference (10 members minimum)
- \*Compete in competitive events at the SLC (at least 5 event entries)
- \*Complete Power of One (at least 5 members)
- \*Appoint a Chapter Service Ambassador; participate in the FLC and SLC service initiatives
- \*Print Fall and Winter Newsletter for a chapter meeting and read selected articles.

### **Additional Point Options: (must complete a minimum of 20 points)**

**Points Options (Show proof of each item with photos, screenshots, and documents, see application for details)**

- 1 Submit an application for a State or National award for recognition at SLC
- 1 Proof of Adviser Appreciation with thank you notes etc.
- 1 Adviser Participation in 2024 Adviser Summit
- 1 Chapter participation in “FCCLA at the table” (Show promotion and proof of participation)
- 1 Send Chapter Photos of activities, events, or NJ FCCLA conferences
- 1 Post Chapter activities on chapter social media page and tag NJ FCCLA
- 2 Chapter participation in Campaign for Tobacco Free Kids Program
- 2 Create a retention program for returning chapter members. Show proof.
- 2 Have members compete in the NJ Say Yes to FCS or the STAR Event Say Yes to FCS
- 2 Create or maintain chapter social media account
- 2 Create an FCCLA bulletin board at your school
- 2 Chapter attendance at the 2024 NLC (2 members 1 adviser)
- 2 Invite State Officers to present and participate at a chapter meeting.
- 2 Sponsor a creative fundraiser
- 2 Sponsor a membership drive
- 2 Complete an adviser award application
- 2 Submit Scholarship application
- 2 Purchase 3 pairs of socks at FLC
- 3 Participate in a collaborative effort with another CTSO or business/industry partner.
- 3 Make a Chapter website
- 3 Compete in STAR Events at SLC. (3 events)
- 3 Participate in 3 of the FCCLA Week initiatives.
- 3 Schedule a meeting with a superintendent or member of your own town’s BOE to advocate for FCCLA.
- 3 Members competed in 2024 NLC STAR Events
- 3 Chapter Participation in the “Safe Rides Save Lives” PSA Contest
- 4 Complete a national program other than Power of One
- 4 Apply for “Go For the Red” Membership Campaign
- 4 Provide an article for the New Directions Newsletter
- 4 Submit and have published an article for a local newspaper
- 4 Had a national STAR Events project recognized as top 10 in the nation at 2024 NLC
- 4 Submitted a service project in the Explore, Act, Tell. service program
- 4 Meet with your school district superintendent and speak at a BOE meeting about the value of FCS and FCCLA
- 5 Mentor a new chapter
- 5 Meet with a member of NJ State Legislature to advocate for FCCLA and FCS Education
- 5 Participation in Japanese Exchange Program
- 5 Run a chapter member for State Office by February 1<sup>st</sup>
- 5 Link NJ FCCLA to a new business partner who is willing to sponsor a state scholarship
